They're about to open, and they're about to wow the citynew luxury high-rises in the West End (Westlight), The Wharf (VIO) and Shaw (880 P). While each of these properties will cast unique shadows in their respective 'hoods, they also have something in common: amenities hard to ignore and extremely easy to love.



Westlight, with 71 condos opening this summer, is the gorgeous creation of IBG and EastBanc. The location, nestled between Georgetown and Dupont Circle—with The Ritz-Carlton, Four Seasons and Fairmont within a five-minute walk—is perfect. The floor plans, with many boasting three bedrooms, go up to nearly 3,100 square feet with dens or libraries.
